MIAMI (OCT. 27, 2020) — The Latin Recording Academy® announced additional performers for the 21st Annual Latin GRAMMY Awards®, including current nominees **Anuel AA, Calibre 50, Julio Reyes Copello, Alex Cuba, Guaynaa, Víctor Manuelle, Ricardo Montaner, Debi Nova, Raquel Sofía** and **Sebastián Yatra**.
